TIBERINUS: a shrine of the river-god on the insula Tiberina. The day of dedication was probably 8th December, when the festival was celebrated (Fast. Amit. ad vi Id. Dec., CIL i². p. 245, 336; Fast. Ant. NS 1921, 118). Its exact location is not known, nor anything of its history (HJ 637; WR 224; Besnier 308-309; Rosch. v. 934). See Carcopino, *Virgile et les Origines d'Ostie* (Bibi. Éc. Franç. fasc. 116), 561 sqq., for a theory that Thybris was the original river-god, and his identification with Volcanus.³

³ Mommsen (CIL i². p. 325) identifies him with Portunus.
